

SOIL CONDITIONER DIRECTIONS

GENERAL: 1 cup per 100 square feet (10' x 10').

FLOWERS AND SHRUBS: General: $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per 100 sq. ft. = (10 x 10).
For large shrubs use 1 lb. per shrub worked into top soil. Bench: Use 1 tablespoon per 12 sq. ft. (3 x 4).

6 in. Pot: Use a pinch. When planting or repotting use 1 teaspoon mixed well into soil.

Large Trees: Use $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. per 1 inch diameter (4' trunk use 2 lbs. of kelp meal) Broadcast in the dripline area of tree.

VEGETABLES AND GENERAL CROPS: (Greenhouse)

Hot Beds or Frames: Use 4 tablespoons per 18 sq. ft. (3 x 6).

Bench: Use 2 tablespoons per 12 sq. ft. (3 x 4).

Use 200 lbs. per acre - spreading with 2 wheel spreader and scale set at No. 9 - or broadcast by hand.

VEGETABLE AND TRUCK GARDENS: Use 200 to 300 lbs. per acre. Either side dress or spread on surface in early spring or late fall. It can be cultivated into the top soil after plowing.

PASTURE, RANGE and PADDOCKS: Use 150 to 250 lbs. to the acre. Fall or early spring is the best time for application.

FARM CROPS:

A. CORN: Cultivate into top soil, 200 to 300 lbs. per acre or side dress 100 lbs. per acre.

B. WHEAT, RYE, BARLEY, OATS: 200 lbs. per acre, applied with drill.

C. ALFALFA, TIMOTHY, etc.: 200 lbs. per acre, applied with drill.

FRUIT TREES: PEACH, PEAR, APPLE: Apply 2 to 4 lbs. per tree under drip line in early spring or late fall.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS:

If not already in feed, add to grain ration 2% ALGIT (40 lbs. to each ton of grain). Either premix or place on feed by hand.

Good for all animals—CATTLE, HOGS, POULTRY, SHEEP, GOATS, HORSES, MINK, PETS, etc.

Where mineral or vitamin deficiency exists, feed up to 5%. Start young animals at 1%. Hogs like ALGIT and eat readily. Hogs may be fed free choice. It is said cattle cannot judge mineral needs - initially forced feeding may be required. When accustomed, cattle will relish ALGIT.

FEED SUPPLEMENT DIRECTIONS

BEEF CATTLE: Feed 2 lb. of seaweed meal mixed with 100 lb. of regular feed ration; or 40 lb. of seaweed meal mixed with 1 ton of feed; or free choice, 2 lb. seaweed meal mixed with 1 lb. salt.

RANGE CATTLE: Free choice at 2 lb. seaweed meal to 1 lb. of regular cattle salt mixed together.

DAIRY CATTLE SAME METHOD AS BEEF CATTLE FEEDING, AND FREE CHOICE: If dairy cattle refuses mineral ration at first when given free choice, add 1 part dried molasses to the free choice mineral ration.

SWINE: Feed 2 lb. of seaweed meal mixed with 100 lb. of regular feed ration, or 40 lb. of seaweed meal mixed with 1 ton of feed.

SHEEP - GOATS: On pasture feed free choice at 2 parts meal to one part salt mixed.

CHICKENS (BROILERS OR LAYERS): 1% of total feed pre-mixed

TURKEYS: 1 to 2% of total feed pre-mixed.

HORSES IN GENERAL: Approximately 1½ oz. daily.

STUDS: 1½ - 2 oz. daily

BROOD MARES: 1 to 2 oz. daily, hand feed if possible.

RACE HORSES: On track - 1% of Grain Feed.
